Students Opinion about our College Facilities Academic year 2017-18

The students at the end of final year just before the final exam were asked to give feed back for the facilities provided by the college as per the questionnaire developed by the Directorate of Collegiate Education to facilitate students enrolling in the ensuing years to perform well in their academic career.

The five point scale was used for evaluation of students on the rating factors like library and information centre, play ground facilities, cultural activities, grievance redress cell, disbursal of scholarship, computer facility, hygiene and nutritious food in canteen, co-operation of administrative staff and availability of Principal for the students.

The feedback was collected from 155 students and it has revealed that among the major facilities, 76.12% of students expressed the playground/sports facilities as excellent. Cultural activities, disbursal of scholarships and most importantly the drinking water/ toilet and cleanliness was scored as excellent by around 60% of students. 59.35% of students have scored the library and information centre as excellent followed by the reading room facility (55.48%) the facilities like grievance cell, remedial classes, co-operation of administrative staff and hygiene and taste of food in canteen have scored less than 50% which indicates that these points needs attention for the academic improvement of the students. One of the factor i.e., availability of Principal in the college for resolving the students problem has a score of 80.66% indicating that the Principal has to devote some more of his time for the redressal of the problems of students in spite of his busy schedule.

With respect to reading room and taking remedial classes, 5.81% and 7.09% of students respectively expressed the aforementioned rating factors as unsatisfactory followed by computer facility and grievance redressal cell (4.5%). The college administration needs to look in to these matters for students academic excellence.
