Thus, by the beginning of 2009 the concept captivated the imagination of various nations across the globe.

Smart city is a developed urban area that creates sustainable economic development and high quality of life by excelling in multiple key areas, which includes economy, mobility, environment, public governance through application of some smart solutions. It is an urban development vision to integrate information and Communication Technology (ICT) and Internet of Things Technology (IoT) in a secure fashion to manage a city assets. Smart city assures water and electricity supply, sanitation and solid waste management, efficient urban mobility and public transport, robust IT connectivity, e-governance and citizen participation, safety and security of citizens.

To accommodate the massive urbanization, India needs to find smarter ways to manage complexities, reduce expenses, increase efficiency and improve the quality of life. The Government of India in its Budget 2016 allocated nearly Rs.7,290 crores for smart cities i.e. AMRUT (Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation) which was launched by Prime Minister Narendra Modi in June 2015 and nearly 100 cities are selected.

India has also been inviting foreign partnership in developing the smart cities and has signed deals to build eight cities, three with Germany, three with the US and one each with Spain and Singapore. Therefore, there are many advantages in promoting smart cities in terms of national benefit, although the whole subject is still in its embryonic stages. So, there is a need for seminars, debates and discussions. Perhaps it is advisable to start with a smart seminar as an "action research".



Proceedings of the Seminar

One Day UGC sponsored National Level Seminar was organized on 16th September 2017 by the Dept. of Economics, SJM Arts College for Women, Chitradurga in association with Davanagere University, Economics Teachers Association. The Seminar commenced at 10.00 am with inaugural session invoked by Nagashri B. Smt. Gayathiri P.C. Associate Professor. Dept. of Economics welcomed the gathering.

The seminar was Inaugurated by His Holiness Dr. Shivamurthy Murugha Sharanaru, the President of S.J.M. Vidyapeetha, Chitradurga. Addressing the Inaugural speech, Swamiji expressed opinion about the seminar commenting on the lack of civic sense and common sense in today's society which leads to the rise of many civic problems in the city. We are in the age of smartness. But mobile games like 'Blue whale' are threatening the life of children in the name of recreation in modern age. By physical smartness it not possible to create smart cities. Instead, vachanas of sharanas can definately bring about a change in the behavior of people through which development of cities is possible.

When we look at our cities we can just guess the type of administration in existence. Corruption has grown to such an extent that the elected representatives and policy makers are developing only but not their work towards the city improvement. No change has been brought about in the life condition of people with their assurances. When there is no vision about the development with our elected representatives how can they develop a clean and smart city? If we just talk about development it doesn't yield any result. Development should not remain in slogan but it should get implemented. Swamiji also said the topic selected for

the seminar is of much concern for all and extremely useful to the policy executives.

Swamiji concluded his remarks saying that this type of seminar will be a lesson for local bodies like municipality and other administrative offices. Perception of smart city is very difficult when there is a lack of co-ordination and honesty between the elected bodies and offices. At the end, His Holiness extended thanks to the organizer for arranging this National Seminar at the institution and the city of chitradurga should also be developed as a smart city. The local bodies and citizen of chitradurga must strive hard to convert it into a smart city.

Dr. Abdual Aziz, senior Economist, ISEC, Bangalore in his key note address to the gathering, he explained the meaning of smart city, it means providing good infrastructure. Concept of smart city varies from city to city and nation to nation, depending on the level of development, changes and reforms, resources and aspiration of the residents. A smart city in India has a different connotation.

The imagination of smart city of any resident of the city in India is infrastructural needs of citizens, which aims at the developing the entire urban eco system. It depends on the four pillars of development, institutional, Physical, Social and Economic infrastructure. The cities must work towards developing comprehensive infrastructure.

A smart city is a locality which is highly developed in nature with excellent infrastructure. It is also a digitally connector with brilliant information technology and is known for its technological advancement in engineering and applied Science. The core elements of smart city include sufficient water supply, adequate electricity, good sanitation, excellent road ways and public transportation, well established health and education centers and much more apart from that is it must also have a good waste management system, Affordable housing schemes, citizen's friendly governance, developed open spaces and environmental protection Programme.

The object behind smart city is to identify the developed region in India vigorously. It will help in developing overall development and industrialization of Indian sub continent. The cities identified to establish smart cities have some criteria such as capital city, industrial and business centers, areas highly influenced by tourism industry, port cities and health and education hubs.

Therefore the smart city initiative is one of the most ambitious measures taken by the Central Government to urbanize India and also to recognize our Nation as one of the most developed country in the Universe.

Sri. K.V. Prabhakar, Secretary, S.J.M. Vidyapeetha, Chitradurga. Dr. E. Chitrashekar, Executive Director (General), S.J.M. Vidyapeetha, Chitradurga. Sri. Neeraj kumar sinha, Asst. General Manager, SBI. Chitradurga, were the Chief Guests in this function. Principal Prof. C. Basavarajappa, Presided over this function.

Prof. N. Chaluvvaraju, IQAC Co- ordinator & Chief Librarian rendered Vote of thanks to one and all. Kum. Meera yadav J. Anchored the function.

The first Technical session started at 11.40 am Dr. M.D. Bhavaiah, Prof. of Economics & Director, centre for studies on social Exclusion and Inclusive policies, Sri. Krishnadevaraya University, Ananthapuramu, Andhra Pradesh, Spoke on Evolution of Smart City- A Concept: Factors and obstacles.

Prof. Bhavaiah in his presentation he quoted the ideas of smart city concept he compare the smart city with the "Singapur model". The concept of smart city had a special character, mainly it must have a proper drainage system. In Singapur if any of the citizen violates or misbehaves then it fetches the imposition of penalty at least ten times the punishment.

The road traffic network is highly disciplined with C.C.T.V. connectivity. The roads are bifurcated in two tracks one track is for floating of vehicles and another tract is only meant for footpath. Hence there will not be accidents in Singapur. In

the traffic and Transport activities the city of Singapore is following discipline for eg. After closing the door the vehicles will start. In Singapore there will be separate area reserved for smokers and it is called smokers zone. The residents should follow the rules, especially for the formation of smart city, then only it has a special character of smart city perspective.

He also expressed his opinion that if we want smart city then especially support of youth is necessary also the mindset of the people (residents) should be changed. For a smart city we should build up greenery in the city and to establish health related activities. There should be a plan to grow trees inside the city area to protect and maintain the environment and atmosphere. He observed that there is a need of replacement of 50 year old trees, also to provide system of ward wise drinking water distribution and to provide good drinking water.

Hence he said further that the electricity supply may be substituted with other source of energy like solar energy etc.,

There is a much concern in Singapore for established it as a smart city. To say about this, the attitude of people should be changed and there is a need of change to establish the smart city. Hence there must be a change in health and education system and it is badly needed. To say in Singapore the Vice-Chancellor of a University is using bicycle for his conveyance to avoid the air pollution.

Dr. B.P. Veerabhadrappe, Professor and Dean of Arts faculty, Dept. of Studies in Economics Shivagangothri Campus, Davanagere, who was a Chair person of this session while addressing he posed the thought provoking question. Why we want smart city? And is it necessary to have a smart city?

He expressed his view that India has 5000 Years of great civilization, we had been familiar smart city perception from past. Now we have come across the line of innovative thinking like swatch bharath, etc., we are facing the problem, how to achieve the smart city or reach the concept and idea of smart city. According to him many a cosmopolitan cities and metropolitan cities will take 'U' turn ie., they

are coming back to village environment because these cities are hub of health and other problems. Especially some cities are facing terrific situation in respect to these problems.

Second Technical Session start at 12.40pm. Sri Niraj Kumar, Master of public Policy, National Law School of India University. (NLSIU) Bangalore has delivered a speech on "The scope for promotion of smart cities in Karnataka". That in Karnataka some districts in the southern region are selected for smart city development scheme. The smart city will have infrastructure that provide urban amenities for leading a civilized life. Four type of infrastructural development for smart cities are Institutional, Physical, Social and Economic. The institutional infrastructure which ensures good governance in the form of smart governing institution like municipality or corporation. The Physical infrastructure includes, housing, drainage, drinking water, parks, roads and play grounds etc., The Economic infrastructure consists of transport facilities, market and market yards, investment houses, traders and consumers association, electricity supplies, industries and other service providing institutions.

Some of the other forms of infrastructure as slum clearance and rehabilitation of slum dwellers, adequate water supply, 24 hours electricity supply, underground sanitation with efficient solid waste management system. The other facilities like public transport system for affordable urban mobility good governance with transparency and accountability, participation in decision making, robust IT connectivity, digitalization and online bill payment. To provide top class health and education facility to all class of people. Safety and security of citizens particularly to women, children and aged (old) persons, and finally pollution control system and also planting trees and establishment of parks are all the important features of smart city.

Six cities in Karnataka are selected for smart city mission namely Hubballi, Dharward, Shivamogga, Davanagere, Tumkur and Mangalore. But the mission not included the cities of North Eastern region and South Western Region in Karnataka. The scope of smart city must be widened.

One more Resource person of this Second Technical Session Mr. Sunil V. Manager, State Bank of India, Chitradurga, he in his presentation stated, the vision and mission of the State Bank of India and also the values of the Bank. He speaks about the Role of Bank in developing the smart cities and how the banks are assisting in building our great nation.

Now the Banks has 60,000 ATM facility for money transaction offers Digital services such as: Internet banking, Mobile Banking, D-mat Services, Payment of service charges, and fees through bill desking, Aadhaar Seeding, Cash Deposit machines, etc.,

The basic concept of smart city is primarily economically driven. The core elements of smart city are adequate water supply assured electricity, sanitation, waste management, public transport, housing facilities, digitalization, good governance, safety and security of citizens, particularly women, children and the elderly, and health and education.

To achieve the above, the financial management with the help of banking services is needed. The misappropriation development funds can be avoided through existing banking system.

Today SBI is one of the best technological platform for money transaction, every individual customer may become self-reliant.

The factor digitalization, like e-finance SBI is offering financial support to customer. From loans for construction of houses, purchase of vehicles, personal loans the Bank is offering support in a big way to business entrepreneurs. SBI is one of the leading Banks in implementing schematic lending to all sectors.

Finance is also being given to Government and Quasi Government bodies to implement various projects like the ones enumerated under smart city initiatives.

In his conclusion Banks plays a role of integral part of the development of smart city and to up bring the people banks take lead in the development of all community activities. So a smart bank has commitment to ensure the main purpose of smart city.

Dr.K.B. Rangappa, Professor Dept. of studies in economics, Shivagangothri Campus, Davanagere, Chair Person of this session concluded with the remarks regarding health and peaceful life, participation of people is necessary for the smart city. The application of technology is essential for smart city. For any of the smart city should have the notion of inclusive growth.

Paper presentation Session was started after the lunch break at 2.45pm. In this session papers were presented by Professors, research Scholars and students of different Colleges and Universities. Paper presentation session was held in two different halls. Hence, the rooms were divided as part- 1 and part -2 of third session. In part -1 Dr. G. Narayana Rao, Rtd. Professor, Shimogga was Chair person. Simultaneously Papers were presented in part - 2 of the same session was Chaired by Dr. Hanumanthappa, Principal, M.S.B. Arts and Commerce College, Davanagere.

Valedictory Session started at 4.00pm. Prof. T.H. 
